Zero percent ( $0 \%$ ) for property tax relief.
The specific purposes for which the revenue shall otherwise be expended are: One hundred percent (100\%) for community betterment, including, but not limited to payment for debt, construction costs, capitalized repair funds, and any other costs associated with the following projects: 1.) The historic preservation of the Marion County Courhouse. 2.) Capital Improvement projects, construction, and repair. 3.) The improvement of Marion County Secondary Road Projects. 4.) Other community betterment projects or any lawful purpose of the Marion County, lowa, Board of Supervisors by Resolution.
